VRE to discuss Midday Storage Facility at Community Meeting

Alexandria, VA. – Virginia Railway Express (VRE) announced today the public is invited to participate in the first community meeting for the Virginia Railway Express Midday Storage Facility project.

The purpose of the VRE Midday Storage Facility project is to replace the current storage space leased from Amtrak at the Ivy City Coach Yard in the District of Columbia. The project will include planning, designing, and constructing a permanent midday storage facility for VRE trains that travel to the District. The proposed facility will be used to store commuter trains on weekdays, between the inbound morning commute and the outbound afternoon commute. VRE will work with members of the community, stakeholders, and property owners to assess potential impacts and determine ways VRE can be a good neighbor.
